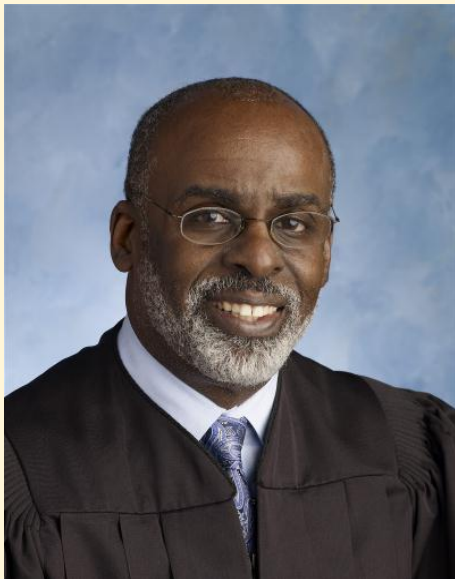

Hon. Judge Ronald B. Adrine

Cleveland Municipal Court



Ronald B. Adrine has become one of the most respected judges in Cleveland, as well as a national authority on issues concerning domestic violence.

Over the years, Judge Adrine has belonged to more than 60 organizations, serving on the boards of more than 30 of those organizations, and holding a leadership position on more than 20 of those boards. He chaired the Ohio Commission on Racial Fairness. He is a past chair of the Ohio Supreme Court's Interpreter Services Advisory Committee and the National Board of Directors of Futures Without Violence, formerly known as the Family Violence Prevention Fund. He also chaired both Cleveland's Domestic Violence Coordinating Council and the Advisory Board of the National Judicial Institute on Domestic Violence, which is a joint initiative of the National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges, Futures Without Violence and the U.S. Department of Justice. He currently sits as a member of the Board of Directors of the National Center for State Courts.
